


How to submit a nomination for an AGU journalism award:

To submit a nomination, visit the [journalism awards nomination system](#) home page. Before you can submit a nomination, you will need to login to the system by clicking the “Continue Log in” button on the left-hand side of the screen.



You will then be directed to a login screen. You will need to login to the system using your AGU account. If you do not have an AGU account, you will need to create one by selecting the “Sign me up as a new user” and filling out the required information.

Note: If your organization is not listed or can't be found, please enter Organization Not Listed in the “Organization Name” field and fill out the “Suggest Your Organization” field with the name of your organization.

The American Geophysical Union is accepting nominations for its 2019 journalism awards through 15 March 2019.

- **David Perlman Award for Excellence in Science Journalism—News**, recognizing excellence in science news reporting, generally produced under deadline pressure of one week or less.
- **Walter Sullivan Award for Excellence in Science Journalism—Features**, recognizing excellence in science feature reporting, generally produced under a deadline of longer than one week.
- **Robert C. Cowen Award for Sustained Achievement in Science Journalism**, recognizing a journalist or team of journalists who have made significant, lasting, and consistent contributions to accurate reporting on the Earth and space sciences for the general public.

The Perlman and Sullivan awards each honor specific stories reported by journalists in the past year (i.e. 2019 awards honor 2018 stories). Journalists are welcome to nominate their own work for these awards, or someone may nominate a story on the reporter's behalf. Nominations may be from any country, in any language (English translation required), and in any news medium, except books. Eligible news stories must be about one or more of the scientific disciplines represented by AGU. A nominee may submit only one entry for each award in a given year (i.e. one entry for the Perlman and one entry for the Sullivan). Each award consists of a plaque and a \$5,000 award.

The Cowen Award celebrates a career of outstanding reporting on Earth and space sciences. Self-nominations are not allowed, but anyone (AGU members and non-members) may submit a nomination for the award. Nominations are open to science journalists (or teams of journalists) who each have, over a period of at least 15 years, made significant, lasting, and consistent contributions to accurate reporting on Earth and space sciences for the general public.


Fill out the nomination form. When you have completed the nomination form, you can “Save” the nomination to come back to later, or “Save and Finalize” to submit the nomination.
